

Fathom Replication

Fathom Replication automatically replicates a local Progress database to remote Progress databases running on one or more machines. Once Fathom Replication is installed, configured, and started, replication happens automatically.

Fathom Replication offers users the ability to keep Progress databases identical while also providing a “hot standby” in case of database failure. When a database fails, another becomes active. Therefore, mission-critical data is always available to your users.

Notes:

- 1 Contact the Vermont Systems Sales department for information on purchasing Fathom Replication.
- 2 Customers will get Fathom support directly from Progress technical support.
- 3 The source database must have the .ai file activated.
- 4 In order to use this feature, you must be running Progress version 9.1E or later.

If you are implementing Fathom, you should also consider the following:

- If using WebTrac and/or AppServers, how will Fathom fail-over the brokers, etc.?
- Where should the common receipt location and images for photo-ID be stored?
